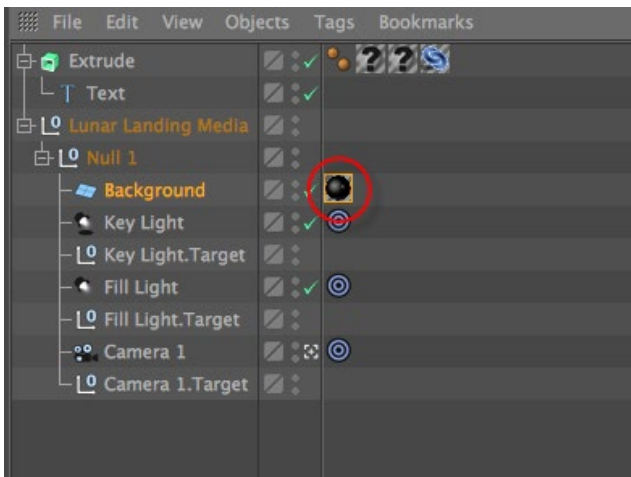


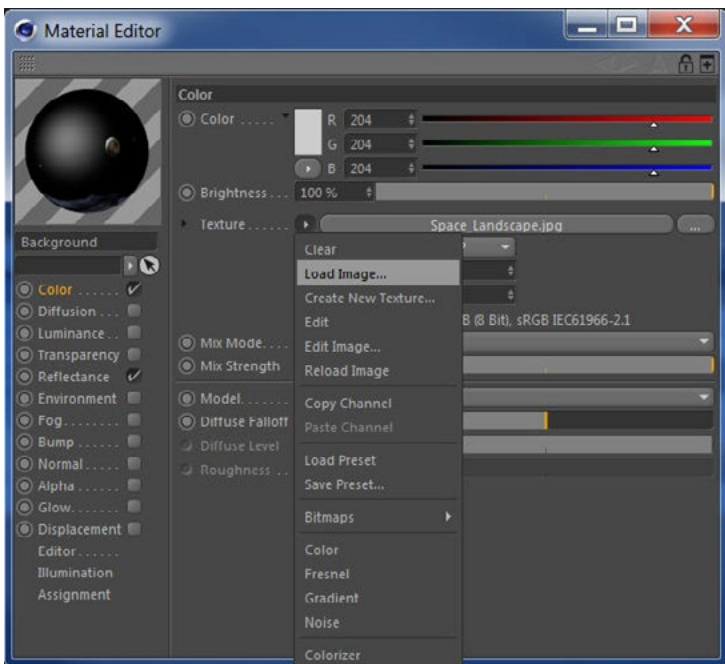
Viewing the Lesson11 end file

Because Cinema 4D links to the original background file (Space Landscape.jpg) in the end file, the background doesn't display if you open the file on a computer that didn't create it or if Cinema4D can't find the background file for another reason. However, you can relink the image in Cinema 4D to view the end file accurately in After Effects. To relink the image in Cinema 4D:

- 1 In After Effects, open the Lesson11_end.aep project file.
- 2 In the Project panel, select the Lesson11.c4d file, and then choose Edit > Edit Original. The file opens in Cinema 4D.
- 3 In Cinema 4D, expand the Lunar Landing Media layer in the Object Manager, in the upper right corner of the application window. Then expand the Null 1 layer.
- 4 Double-click the black ball texture tag next to Background.



- 5 In the Material Manager in the lower right area of the application window, choose Function > Edit.
- 6 In the Material Editor dialog box, choose Load Image from the Texture pop-up menu.



- 7** Navigate to the Lesson11 > Assets > SpaceLandscape.jpg file on your computer, and click Open.
- 8** Click Yes when asked whether you want to save a copy to the project folder.
- 9** Close the Material Editor dialog box
- 10** Choose File > Save to save your changes.
- 11** Close Cinema 4D.

The background image appears as expected in the After Effects project.
